Community Outreach

Rosa's arrival at JCC has focused our services for **new immigrant families.** She works closely with **Community School Coordinators** at Wolfe Street Academy, City Springs, Commodore John Rogers, & Tench Tilghman schools. She supports families needing assistance with housing, food, clothing & more.

LaTia was instrumental in implementing Friday **food distributions** at Wolfe Street Academy in 2023. In Fall/Winter 2022, JCC collaborated on Thanksgiving & Christmas food distributions.

Adult Education

16 students graduated from the Child Care Training Program (CCTP), now in its 12th year. 12 students completed the coursework in Spanish and 4 in English. All successfully completed the 150 hours of courses for certification through MSDE. The teachers from the Instituto de Educación Infantil & the Community College of Baltimore County provided engaging didactic instruction.

Thank you to St. Vincent de Paul Head Start & Patterson Park Public Charter School for supporting internship hours for our students.

In partnership with **Wolfe Street Academy**, **12** parents participated in **beginner level English classes** from April through the end of the school year.

Health Outreach

Health Coordinator, **Lizzy Spradley**, focused her attention on providing ongoing case management and support to individuals needing assistance accessing health care & community support.

Educational workshops & trainings were provided throughout the year including monthly training for childcare providers on the safe administration of medication, community harm reduction & wound care, & classroom seizure management. **147** individuals participated in health education workshops & trainings or received health consultation/assistance during this program year.
